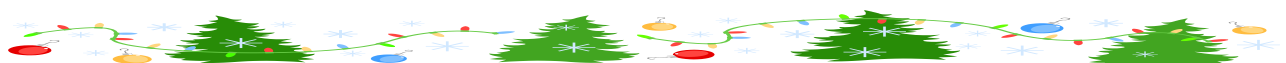


### ADVENT KINDNESS
