

## Pupil Premium 2011-12

Manor Farm Community Infant School was allocated £8,900 for the academic year 2011/12. These monies are in addition to the main school budget.

Part of the money was spent on funding some of the support staff hours – teaching assistants in each class and support assistants who work across the school enabling us to provide small support groups as required. This support is targeted to benefit pupils in a variety of ways.

Additionally some money was spent on enabling pupils to access a variety of extra-curricular activities.

The pupil premium is a relatively new government initiative and we plan to continually explore ways to spend the money as effectively as possible and to monitor assessment information to ascertain what is working best.
