Sports Premium Plan 2014/15

For the academic year 2014/15 we received £8735

We have used this to enhance a variety of ways: to continue professional development for staff as well as supporting activities to help and advance children's skills and to ensure that sports equipment is maintained and stored effectively.

Active Kids	To work alongside teachers delivering a variety of multi-skills activities to enhance teachers' skills and to support new skills being learned across the curriculum.	£2500
Repair of adventure trail	These repairs enabled pupils to use the adventure trail to further develop lots of physical skills during P.E. sessions and play times.	£2250
Wake and Shake	CD's purchased to use across the school to provide short active breaks during the day.	£ 250
Storage facilities	The restructuring of storage spaces will ensure that the P.E. equipment can be kept in appropriate places so they can be used efficiently.	£ 500

The total spend to date is £5,500.

The balance will be spent on updating playground equipment and sourcing and providing high quality CPD for lunchtime staff to enhance playtime activities further. Some will also be spent on the cost of coaches to attend inter-school sports events.

The impact of this sports premium has allowed us to develop the skills and knowledge of staff and provided us with the opportunity to develop sport in a variety of new ways. We now have access to new ideas, plans and the support to implement them, together with opportunities to develop our knowledge of assessing pupil progress in PE.

We have also been able to implement 'mini competitive sports events' with other schools to widen and enrich the collaborative, competitive and fun sports opportunities for the pupils.

Ensuring that equipment has been kept in a good working condition has also meant that the pupils can continue to develop skills on the activity trail.
