Sports Premium Plan 2016/17

For the academic year 2016/17 we have received approximately £8,700

We have used this to enhance sports provision in a variety of ways: to continue professional development for staff as well as supporting activities to help and advance children's skills, to provide more competitive sports opportunities, to provide additional sports equipment and ensure that sports equipment is maintained and stored effectively.

The table below shows how the funds have been spent.

Active Kids	To work alongside teachers delivering a variety of multi-skills activities to enhance teachers' skills and to support new skills being learned across the curriculum.	£2700
Activ Kids lunchtime clubs with sports specialist	To work with children at lunchtimes to provide them further opportunities to develop their sports skills. This will further enhance competitive sports opportunities.	£2900
Improved PE storage	Equipment to be stored more safely and effectively so that access results in more time available for using PE equipment in lesson time.	£1600
Equipment for PE and Forest Schools	PE equipment to be replaced and some equipment for Forest School	£150
Training for Forest School	A member of staff to undergo Forest School training	£250

The total spend to date is £7,600.

The balance of £1,100 will be added to next year's funding.

The funding for 2017/18 will be £17,490 giving a total of £18,590

We plan to use this as shown below:

Activ Kids	£3,000
Active Kids Lunchtime Clubs	£3,000
Update and replace indoor and outdoor equipment	£10,000
Set up and run 'Walk around the World' initiative	£250
