

## Sports Premium Plan

Sports Premium Plan 2017/18

For the academic year 2017/18 we have received £17,490 and with the carried forward amount the total is £18,590

We have used this to enhance sports provision in a variety of ways: to continue professional development for staff as well as supporting activities to help and advance children's skills, to provide more competitive sports opportunities, to provide additional sports equipment and ensure that sports equipment is maintained and stored effectively. We have also provided opportunities for all pupils to attend Forest School in EYFS and Year 1.

The table below shows how the funds have been spent.

Active Kids	To work alongside teachers delivering a variety of multi-skills activities to enhance teachers' skills and to support new skills being learned across the curriculum.	£3000
Activ Kids lunchtime clubs with sports specialist	To work with children at lunchtimes to provide them further opportunities to develop their sports skills. This will further enhance competitive sports opportunities.	£3200
Specialist golf days for Year 2 pupils	To teach the pupils new skills and provide opportunities to further develop these at a golf range	£560
Equipment Forest Schools	Sundries required throughout year	£150
Staffing for Forest schools	A member of staff to lead Forest school and staff to support	£8200
Sports equipment repairs	To keep equipment in good working order	£250

The total spend to date is £15,360

The balance of £3,230 will be added to next year's funding which is approximately £18,800 totalling £22,030.

We plan to use this during 2018/19 as shown below:

Activ Kids (dance training and enhancement) £3,500

Active Kids Lunchtime Clubs £4,000

Forest school session for EYFS and Year 1 £9,000

The balance to be decided upon throughout the academic year.
