It was lovely to see so many EYFS parents joining us during Communication Week to read with their children. These moments are so valuable in fostering a love of language and reading from an early age.

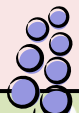

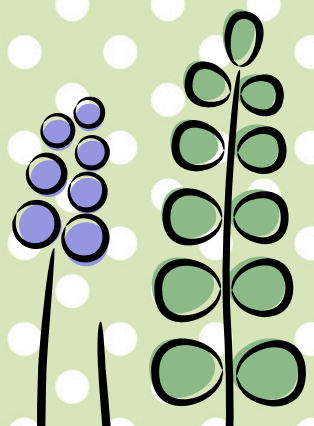

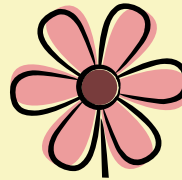
